

Air Travel Information for Parents



Asbury Hills is happy to offer transportation for campers arriving or departing from Greenville-Spartanburg International Airport (GSP). Please read and communicate this information with your child to ensure a smooth pick-up / drop-off process. Please note that all forms and payments must be completed before your child can be scheduled for airport pick-up or drop-off.

1. Pick-up / Drop-off Times and Locations

All campers must arrive on the Sunday and depart on the Friday of his/her respective session. All camper flights must arrive or depart to / from Greenville-Spartanburg (GSP) International Airport between 10AM and 2PM. Asbury Hills will do its best to have a staff member waiting at the gate for arrivals and seeing the camper to the gate for departures. This is not guaranteed, and in the event that Asbury Hills staff are unable meet your camper at the gate, they will meet them at baggage claim. We ask that campers do their best not to leave baggage claim and look for us, as we will be looking for them. Please communicate this to your child. If special arrangements must be made, please call the camp office at (864) 836-3711.

2. Contacting Asbury Hills Staff

Once we receive the form attached form, we will be in contact with you regarding your child's travel plans. We will be giving you the name and contact number of the staff member who is to pick up your child. This should be your first contact on the day of travel. We encourage you to contact Asbury Hills staff in the event of any change in plans (flight delay, flight cancellation, camper sickness, etc). We also ask that if your child is traveling with a cell phone, that you include that number on the form below. We will only use this information to contact your child in the event of an emergency or significant change in plans. Please make sure your child has the name and contact number of the staff member planning to pick up your child and these numbers as well:

If you are unable to reach the specific staff member picking up or dropping off your child, please call these numbers and we will communicate the message.

3. Unaccompanied Minor

We recommend, but do not require, that your child travels as an "unaccompanied minor." This offers the smoothest process for your child. If you choose this option, it is also recommended that you pre-pay for it along with your ticket for both to and from camp, to avoid the necessity of your child carrying any money.

4. Forms / Payments

All registration forms for summer camp must be completed and all payments made before we can schedule your child for airport pick-up or drop-off. Once all forms are completed, and we receive the Air Travel Request Form (below), we will contact you to confirm the travel arrangements. **There is a \$50 charge for a one-way flight and \$75 charge for round trip** for campers to be picked up or dropped off at the airport.

5. Baggage

Baggage can be sent along with the camper on the flight or it can be shipped via UPS / FedEx. If you are shipping baggage, please be sure to send it with enough time to arrive at camp. With all baggage, be sure to mark it clearly with your child's name on the outside of the bag. It is not necessary to lock luggage, but if you choose to do so, be sure to send the key with your camper.

6. Safety

For safety, we have a few regulations that we enforce during travel at Asbury Hills. All of our staff members transporting campers have passed driving tests and are at least 21 years of age. All of our vehicles are equipped with first aid supplies, and our drivers are trained in First Aid/CPR. We maintain a 1:7 ratio of staff to campers while traveling. We require seatbelts for all passengers. Your child will be reminded of these and other relevant policies before traveling with Asbury Hills.
